## CATTAIL (BULLRUSH)

NATIVE PLANT

• Can grow to 3 m tall

Iris pseudacorus

**YELLOW** 





No purple at the base of shoots

Shoots have purple coloring at the base

**FLAG IRIS INVASIVE PLANT TOXIC** 

- Can grow 1.5 m tall
- Flowers in early June
- · Sap can cause skin irritations, do not consume this plant

**LEAVES** 



Cattail leaves do not fan out from the base

Iris leaves form a fanshape at the base of the plant



**CROSS SECTION** 



Leaves are D-shaped: Flat on one side and rounded on the other

Leaves are flat and have a ridge down the middle



**STEM** 



Stems are round and have a honeycomb-like structure

Stems are almondshaped, often with a purple hue



**FLOWER** 



Flowers are thick. brown, and cigarshaped spikes

Flowers are vellow, with three upright and three drooping sepals/petals
